Hail the day that sees him rise, Alleluia! Some forty days after the Resurrection, our Lord rose to the heavens, out of the sight of his disciples, where now he reigns. His Church is left in our hands by the power and guidance and mercy of the Holy Spirit. Like graduating from school, the Ascension marks not simply an ending or completion, but a pivot towards a new beginning at a higher plane of consciousness and existence. Where the body of Jesus was limited to the bounds of space and time on this earth, the Mystical Body of Christ has spread far and wide to be the hands of God's mercy to all. MEMORIAL DAY



## Kindergarteners Lead Us In Prayer



During the month of May, the Kindergarten class, along with their teacher, Ms. Mollie Ozment, lead Morning Assembly each day. Every morning we begin with prayer by listening to the Holy Scripture reading for the day and a Living Faith reflection for children and youth. During the Scripture reading all of the Kindergarten leaders serve as the role models for prayer. This class is also teaching our school about Catholic sacramentals, which are associated with blessings and sacraments. "Among sacramentals blessings (of persons, meals, objects, and places) come first. Every blessing praises God and prays for his gifts. In Christ, Christians are blessed by God the Father with every spiritual blessing. This is why the Church imparts blessings by invoking the name of Jesus, usually while making the holy sign of the cross of Christ." (Catechism, No. 1671) Thanks be to God for Kindergarteners who show us the way to pray.


